



From 1<sup>st</sup> October 2014, vehicles still need to be taxed, but there is no legal requirement to display a paper disc.

## Vehicles taxed by Zenith

 Nothing to worry about as these changes don't affect you – apart from you won't receive a paper disc.

## Vehicles NOT taxed by Zenith

## Buying a vehicle

• The vehicle tax will no longer be transferred with the vehicle. You will need to get new vehicle tax before you can use the vehicle.

Selling a vehicle

 If you sell a vehicle after 1<sup>st</sup> October and you have notified DVLA, you will automatically get a refund for any full calendar months left on the vehicle tax.

Vehicle tax refunds

 You will no longer need to make a separate application for a refund of vehicle tax. DVLA will automatically issue a refund when a notification is received from the person named on DVLA vehicle register.
